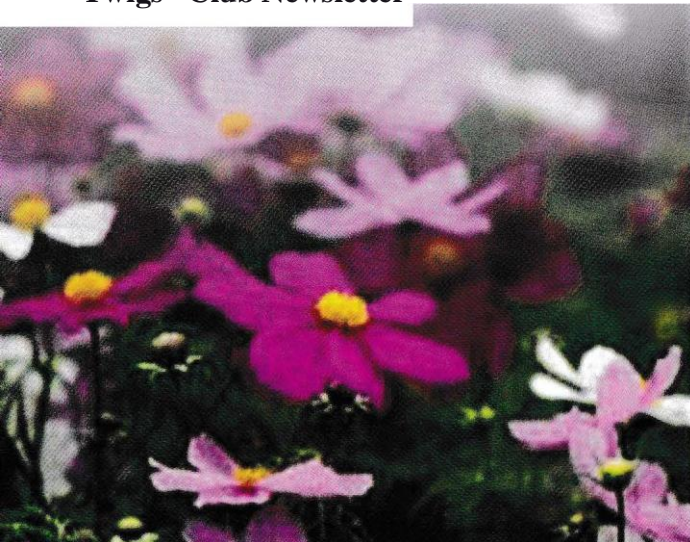

Purchase fresh wreaths, swags, boxwood trees, and holiday arrangements on the first Saturday of December.

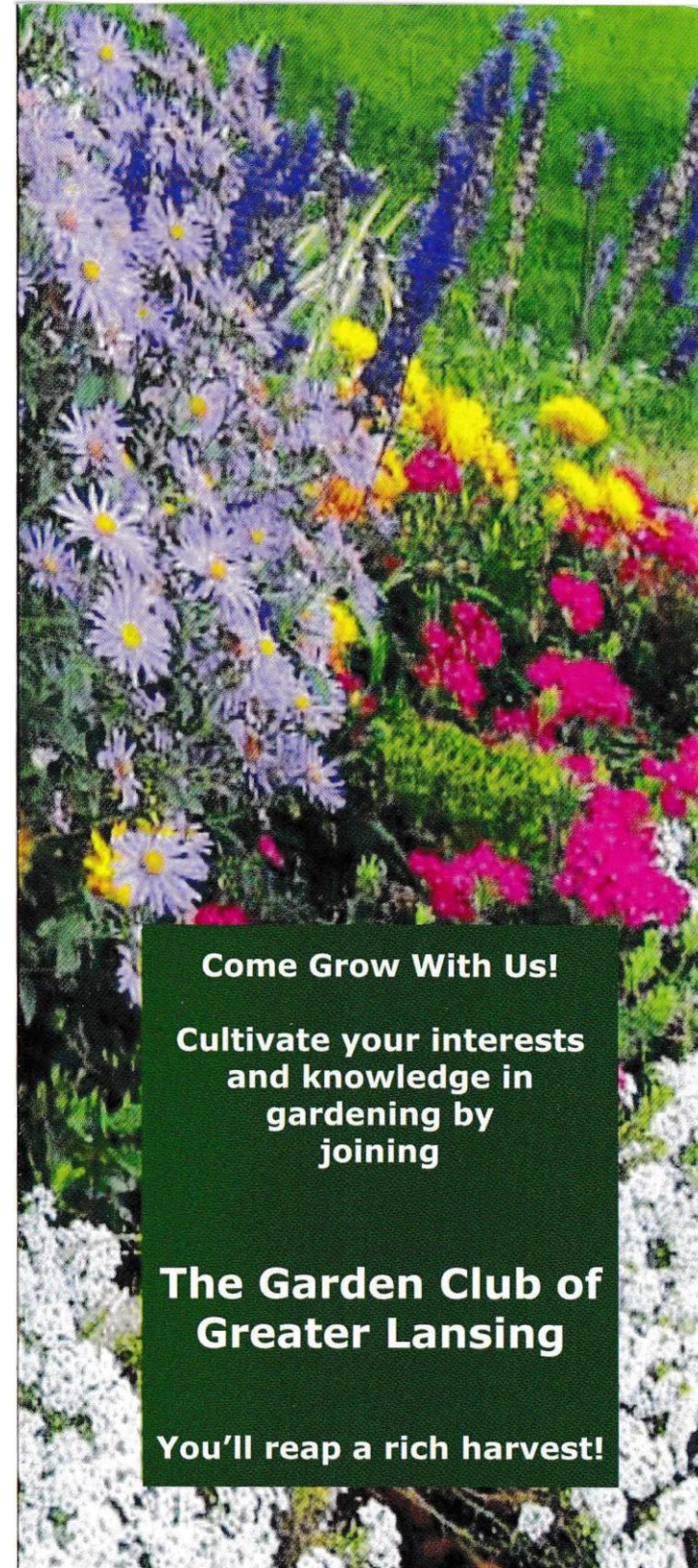
